

# Day 1 - Hometown / Tokyo (Japan) (YVR/NRT ACoo3 1305/1500+1)

Fly with Air Canada to Vancouver from your hometown connecting Air Canada non-stop flight to Tokyo. Start your worry-free vacation with our Canadian Tour Leader.



#### RESERVATIONS AND BOOKING

Reservations for the tour packages shown in this brochure shall be made through registered travel agents. Upon receipt of a required deposit, reservations are firm and will be subject to penalties upon cancellation.

#### **DEPOSIT**

A deposit of C\$500.00 per person is required for reservations within 7 days from the time of booking.

#### **FINAL PAYMENT**

A balance of the tour price shall be made in a full 60 days prior to departure. The tour price for a booking made and accepted within 90 days of departure is payable in full at the time of booking.

#### **CANCELLATION PENALTIES**

All cancellations must be made in writing to Asia Sky Holidays (referred herein as "Asia Sky") by the booking agent. Penalties for any cancellation are to be assessed according to the date of receipt of such cancellation as follows:

- · After the booking has been confirmed: Deposit of C\$500.00 per person is non-refundable.
