#### Day 1 - Hometown / Shanghai (China)

Fly with China Eastern Airlines from Vancouver to Shanghai. Start your worry-free vacation with our Canadian Tour Leader.

#### Day 2 - Arrive in Shanghai

Cross the International Date Line and arrive in Shanghai, explore *Pudong Development Zone* and take a closer look at the *Oriental Pearl TV Tower*. After dinner, transfer to the hotel. (D)

Hotel: Shanghai Jeurong Hotel (5-Star Design)

#### Day 3 - Shanghai

After breakfast, tour the Yuyuan Bazaar, Old Street of City God Temple, then visit the silk factory. Take a stroll along the Bund and visit the famous Nanjing Road shopping street. Huangpu River Night Cruise could be arranged as an optional tour at night (US\$50.00 pp to be paid locally). (B / L / D)

#### Day 4 - Shanghai / Tokyo (Japan)

After breakfast, transfer to Shanghai Airport to Tokyo. Upon arrival, you will be met at the airport and transferred to the hotel. (B)

Hotel: Hotel Metropolitan Ikebukuro (4-Star)

## Day 5 - Tokyo

After breakfast, visit Tokyo's oldest temple, Asakusa Kannon Temple (Sensoji Temple). Then enjoy stunning city views from the Tokyo Skytree Observation Deck. After lunch, explore the Tokyo National Museum, the Imperial Palace East Garden, and the Nijubashi Bridge. In the evening, gather for a Yakiniku Welcome Dinner, where you'll enjoy premium grilled meats and vegetables cooked at your table. (B / L / SD)

#### Day 6 - Tokyo ~ Hakone ~ Mt. Fuji ~ Shizuoka

This morning, travel to Hakone for a *scenic boat cruise on Lake Ashi*, with views of Mt. Fuji on clear days. After lunch, drive to *Mt. Fuji 5th Station* for panoramic views. Return to the hotel after dinner. (B / L / D)

Hotel: Hotel Associa Shizuoka (4-Star)

#### Day 7 - Shizuoka ~ Nagoya

In the morning, take a 2.5-hour bus ride to Nagoya, and visit **Nagoya Castle** for a group photo. Then, visit **Osu Kannon Temple** and wander **Osu Shopping Street** before lunch. In the afternoon, explore the **Toyota Commemorative Museum** and enjoy a **Sukiyaki (Japanese Hotpot) Dinner.** (B / L / SD)

Hotel: Nagoya Kanko Hotel (4-Star)

#### Day 8 - Nagoya ~ Kyoto

After breakfast, take a 2-hour bus ride to Kyoto and visit *Fushimi Inari Shrine*. Experience a *Traditional Tea Ceremony*, then explore the historic *Gion district* and *Hanami-koji Street*, where you might catch a glimpse of geikos (Kyoto's term for geisha) or maikos (geiko apprentices). Dinner is at your arrangement. (B / L)

Hotel: ANA Crowne Plaza Hotel Kyoto (4-Star)

## Day 9 - Kyoto

This morning, explore the serene **Arashiyama Bamboo Grove** and walk across the picturesque **Togetsu Bridge**. Next, visit the stunning **Kinkakuji Temple (Golden Pavilion)**. End the day with a **Western Dinner**. (B / L / WD)

#### Day 10 - Kyoto ~ Nara ~ Kobe

After breakfast, head to Nara to explore *Nara Deer Park* and stroll through the charming *Naramachi area*. Join a fun *sushi-making class* and enjoy your creations for lunch. Afterward, travel to Kobe for a visit to the *Hakutsuru Sake Brewery Museum*, where you'll learn about sake brewing and enjoy a sake tasting. (B / SL) *Hotel: ANA Crowne Plaza Hotel Kobe (4-Star)* 

#### Day 11 - Kobe ~ Hiroshima ~ Kobe (By Bullet Train)

Board the *Shinkansen* (bullet train) to *Hiroshima* in the morning to visit the *Peace Memorial Park and Museum*. Then take a *ferry to Miyajima Island* to explore *Itsukushima Shrine and the floating torii gate*. Return to Kobe by bullet Train in the late afternoon. (B)

#### Day 12 - Kobe ~ Osaka

Start the day at *Kobe Harbourland* and enjoy views from the *Kobe Port Tower Observation Deck*. After a *western lunch*, head to Osaka to explore *Kuromon Market* and *Dotonbori District* for shopping and street food sampling. Enjoy a *Farewell Dinner featuring Japanese Beef.* (B / L / SD)

Hotel: Star Gate Hotel Kansai Airport (4-Star)

#### Day 13 - Osaka / Busan (Korea) (By Air)

After breakfast, transfer to Osaka Kansai International Airport for your flight to Busan. Meet your local guide and visit *Gamcheon Culture Village*. Continue to *Busan International Film Festival Square* and the biggest Fish Market, *Jagalchi Fish Market*. End the day with a delightful *Hanjeongsik Welcome Dinner*. (B / L / SD) *Hotel: Busan Crown Harbor Hotel (4-Star)* 

#### Day 14 - Busan

Today, explore *Haedong Yonggungsa Temple* and walk along Busan's famous *Haeundae Beach* and get a ride on *Haeundae Coastal Train*. Then visit *Oryukdo Skywalk* for panoramic sea views and explore *Taejongdae Cliff*. End the day with a local *Korean Dinner*. (B / L / D)

#### Day 15 - Busan ~ Gyeongju ~ Ansan

After breakfast, drive to Gyeongju. Today, visit 2 UNESCO Heritage sites – *Seokguram Grotto* and *Bulguksa Temple*, then enjoy a *Buffet Lunch at Ashley Restaurant*. Continue the journey to Ansan. End with a local *Korean Dinner*. (B / SL / D)

Hotel: Hotel Square (4-Star)

#### Day 16 - Gyeongju ~ Seoul

After breakfast, visit the *DMZ Area* to experience the *Third Tunnel* and learn about the world's most famous divided border. Enjoy a *Seafood Steamboat Lunch*, then visit the *War Memorial of Korea* and *N Seoul Tower* (observatory not included). Enjoy *The Painters show* (or Nanta). Dinner is at your arrangement. (B / L) *Hotel: Mercure Hotel Seoul Magok (4-Star)* 

#### Day 16 - Seoul

This morning, visit *Gyeongbokgung Palace* where you can dress in traditional *Hanbok*. Enjoy a *Ginseng Chicken Soup Lunch*. Then, explore the *National Folk Museum* and *Bukchon Hanok Village*. Enjoy a *Special Farewell Korean BBQ Dinner* and explore *Myeongdong Night Market* before going back to the hotel. (B / L / SD)

#### Day 17 - Seoul / Hometown (via Shanghai)

This morning, you will transfer to Incheon International Airport to depart for Canada via Shanghai and arrive home on the same day. (B)
