| Day 1 (Sun) | <p>Shenzhen</p> <p>Arrive in Shenzhen on your own and check into the hotel.</p> <p>Overnight: Shangri-La Hotel Shenzhen (5 star, 10 minutes walk from Luo Wu border)</p> |
| Day 2 (Mon) | <p>Shenzhen – Wuhan 【By High-speed train】 </p> <p>After breakfast, transfer to Shenzhen High-speed Railway Station. Take the high-speed rail from Shenzhen to Wuhan. (Lunch on own arrangement on high-speed rail)</p> <p>Reference train schedule: Shenzhen ~ Wuhan G874 1010/1425</p> <p>After arriving in Wuhan, visit the Yellow Crane Tower, the first of the three famous towers in the south of the Yangtze River. The Yellow Crane Tower is located on the Sheshan Mountain in Wuchang. It was first built in the second year of Wu Huangwu (223 AD) in the Three Kingdoms period. It has a history of more than 1,780 years and is a national 5A-level scenic spot. Enjoy Hubei fish feast tonight. (B / D)</p> <p>Overnight: Wuhan Furama Shanshui Hotel (4 star) or similar</p> |
| Day 3 (Tue) | <p>Wuhan – Jingzhou – Yichang - Yangtze Three Gorges (MV Century Oasis) </p> <p>After breakfast, go to Jingzhou and visit Jingzhou Ancient City, known as Jiangling City in ancient times. It is one of the important birthplaces of Chu and Three Kingdoms cultures and one of the four most complete ancient city walls in China. Visit the Jingzhou Museum, which currently houses more than 130,000 cultural relics, most of which are unearthed cultural relics from archaeological excavations, and a few are handed down cultural relics and revolutionary cultural relics. Continue to Yichang Maoping Pier to board the Century Cruise luxury cruise ship. Dinner at the cruise ship restaurant. (B / L / D)</p> <p>Overnight: Century Oasis 5-star cruise ship (balcony cabin, launched in 2023)</p> |
| Day 4 (Wed) | <p>Three Gorges Tour </p> <p>Go ashore to visit the Three Gorges Dam, currently the largest water conservancy project in the world. The dam is 2,335 meters long, 185 meters high at the crest, with a total reservoir capacity of 39.3 billion cubic meters. Visit Tanziling, the highest point of the dam at 262.48 meters, offering panoramic views of the entire structure. Walk to a location near the dam for a close-up view of the five-stage ship locks, then continue to the Three Gorges Dam 185-meter Viewing Platform, which is level with the dam and ideal for photographing the dam integrated with the surrounding mountains.</p> <p>*Optional activity: Guests may experience the Three Gorges Vertical Ship Lift (290 RMB per person, sign up onboard. Limited seats available, first come, first served), a world-class engineering marvel that rises about 100 meters, equivalent to a 40-story building.</p> <p>In the afternoon, the cruise departs, sailing through Xiling Gorge and offering spectacular views of the canyon scenery on both sides. Attend the captain's welcome party in the evening. (B / L / D)</p> <p>Overnight: Century Oasis 5-star cruise ship (balcony cabin, launched in 2023)</p> |

| Day 5 (Thu) | <p data-bbox="310 149 540 180">Three Gorges Tour </p> <p data-bbox="310 205 1511 485">After breakfast, transfer to a small boat to explore Shennü Creek, or "Beauty Creek," a 15-km stretch with 10 km of untouched valley and fairyland-like scenery. Continue cruising through the majestic Wu Gorge, known for its steep peaks and scenic beauty, with highlights like Golden Helmet Gorge and Iron Coffin Gorge. In the afternoon, sail through Qutang Gorge, the starting point of the Yangtze's Three Gorges. At Kuimen, the narrowest point is under 100 meters and appears on the 10-yuan banknote. Disembark to visit White Emperor City, where Liu Bei entrusted his son and where poets Li Bai and Du Fu once wrote. Enjoy an onboard cultural performance in the evening. (B / L / D)</p> <p data-bbox="310 495 1224 527">Overnight: Century Oasis 5-star cruise ship (balcony cabin, launched in 2023)</p> |
| Day 6 (Fri) | <p data-bbox="310 539 540 571">Three Gorges Tour </p> <p data-bbox="310 596 1511 842">Go ashore and visit Fengdu Ghost Town, guests may walk up the hill or take the cable car (Optional round-trip cable car: 35 RMB per person). It was known as the "Bazi Biedu" in ancient times. It was established as a county in the second year of Emperor Yongyuan of the Eastern Han Dynasty. It has a history of nearly 2,000 years. It is located on the north bank of the Yangtze River in Fengdu County, downstream of Chongqing City, across the river from Fengdu New County. Watch the cultural performance on board in the evening. (B / L / D)</p> <p data-bbox="310 852 1224 884">Overnight: Century Oasis 5-star cruise ship (balcony cabin, launched in 2023)</p> |
| Day 7 (Sat) | <p data-bbox="310 905 529 936">Arrive Chongqing </p> <p data-bbox="310 961 1511 1283">After disembarking at Chongqing Pier, visit People's Square to admire the Great Hall of the People, known as the "Little Tiananmen." Continue to Hongya Cave, famous for its 2,300-year history and traditional Bayu-style stilted buildings along the riverside cliffs. Stroll through the lively Jiefangbei Pedestrian District, then enjoy panoramic city views from the Cloud Eye Observation Deck. Lunch is upgraded to the "Qingyu Imperial Banquet," a palace-themed immersive dining experience with live court-style performances. In the evening, enjoy a night tour along Chongqing Binjiang Road to admire the Yangtze River night scenery, with a possible viewing of the "Charming Chongqing" drone light show. Dinner features authentic Chongqing-style Yu cuisine. (B / L / D)</p> <p data-bbox="310 1293 940 1325">Overnight: Chongqing Hilton Hotel (5-star) or similar</p> |
| Day 8 (Sun) | <p data-bbox="310 1346 621 1377">Chongqing (full day tour) </p> <p data-bbox="310 1402 1511 1648">After breakfast, visit Liziba Viewing Platform to see the monorail pass through a building, then explore Longmenhao Old Street. After lunch, tour Huguang Guild Hall, the largest surviving urban guild hall complex in China, showcasing Qing Dynasty migration history and diverse architectural styles. Next, visit Shibati, a time tunnel connecting Chongqing's past and present, reflecting the city's history and local life. Dinner features authentic Chongqing hotpot, with individual hotpot servings (one pot per person). (B / L / D)</p> <p data-bbox="310 1659 940 1690">Overnight: Chongqing Hilton Hotel (5-star) or similar</p> |

| Day 9 (Mon) | <p>Chongqing ~ Dazu Rock Carvings ~ Leshan </p> <p>After breakfast, visit the Dazu Rock Carvings, a UNESCO World Heritage site from the late Tang and early Song Dynasties. Featuring Buddhist themes, the cliff statues on Beishan and Baoding Mountains are renowned for their grand scale, exquisite carvings, and rich themes, showcasing the essence of China's "three religions"—Buddhism, Taoism, and Confucianism. It's a treasure of Chinese grotto art. head to Leshan and enjoy a Leshan-style feast tonight. (B / L / D)</p> <p>Overnight: Leshan Hualuxe Hotel (5 star) or similar</p> |
| Day 10 (Tue) | <p>Leshan ~ Giant Buddha ~ Chengdu </p> <p>After breakfast, visit the Giant Buddha of Leshan, also known as the Lingyun Giant Buddha. Carved into the cliffs of Lingyun Mountain on the Min River' s eastern bank, this seated Maitreya Buddha is the largest cliff-side statue in China and the world's largest stone-carved seated Maitreya Buddha. After the tour, head to Chengdu to visit Kuanzhai Alley (Wide and Narrow Alley), which consists of Kuan (Wide) Alley, Zhai (Narrow) Alley and Jing (Well-shaped) Alley arranged in parallel. These antique courtyard houses retain the style of Qing Dynasty streets. Along with Daci Temple and Wenshu Monastery, they are part of Chengdu' s three protected historical and cultural districts. Enjoy classic Sichuan cuisine banquet at night. (B / L / D)</p> <p>Overnight: Sheraton Chengdu Lido Hotel (5 star) or similar</p> |
| Day 11 (Wed) | <p>Chengdu ~ Panda Base ~ Sanxingdui Museum </p> <p>Today, visit the Giant Panda Breeding Research Base, 10 kilometers away from the city center. It is a world-famous important base for the protection, breeding and research of giant pandas. It covers an area of 1,000 acres to protect and breed giant pandas, red pandas, etc. After lunch, proceed to visit the Sanxingdui Museum, a modern specialized archaeological museum showcasing the bronze-age ruins of Southwest China. Two large sacrificial pits from the Shang Dynasty were discovered, and thousands of rare treasures were revealed: the bronze sacred tree, golden staffs, large bronze statues, etc. are among the best in the world. The discovery of Sanxingdui also pushes back the history of the ancient Shu Kingdom to 5,000 years ago, making it one of the most historically, scientifically, and artistically significant archaeological sites. Return to Chengdu for Roast Duck dinner at Quanjude Restaurant. (B / L / D)</p> <p>Overnight: Sheraton Chengdu Lido Hotel (5 star) or similar</p> |
| Day 12 (Thu) | <p>Chengdu – Shenzhen 【By High-speed train】 </p> <p>* High-speed rail direct to Hong Kong can be booked on behalf (C\$35 per person)</p> <p>After breakfast, take a tourist bus to Chengdu High-speed Railway Station and take the high-speed rail to Shenzhen (North) (Lunch at your own expense on the high-speed rail)</p> <p>Reference train schedule: Chengdu ~ Shenzhen (North) G2963 1042/1833</p> <p>After arriving in Shenzhen, guests will arrange their own transportation back to their place of origin. (B)</p> |
