Day 1 – Hometown / Tokyo (Japan)

Day 2 – Arrive in Tokyo

Cross the International Date Line to Japan. Upon arrival, you will be met at the airport and transferred to the hotel.

Hotel: Hotel Metropolitan Ikebukuro (4-Star)

Day 3 - Tokyo

After breakfast, visit Tokyo's oldest temple, **Asakusa Kannon Temple (Sensoji Temple)**. Then enjoy stunning city views from the **Tokyo Skytree Observation Deck**. After lunch, explore the **Tokyo National Museum, the Imperial Palace East Garden, and the Nijubashi Bridge**. In the evening, gather for a **Yakiniku Welcome Dinner**, where you'll enjoy premium grilled meats and vegetables cooked at your table. (B / L / SD)

Day 4 - Tokyo ~ Hakone ~ Mt. Fuji ~ Shizuoka

In the afternoon, explore the **Toyota Commemorative Museum** and enjoy a **Sukiyaki (Japanese Hotpot) Dinner**. (B / L / SD)

Day 6 - Nagoya ~ Kyoto

After breakfast, take a 2-hour bus ride to Kyoto and visit **Fushimi Inari Shrine**. Experience a **Traditional Tea Ceremony**, then explore the historic **Gion district** and **Hanami-koji Street**, where you might catch a glimpse of geikos (Kyoto's term for geisha) or maikos (geiko apprentices). Dinner is at your arrangement. (B / L)

Day 7 - Kyoto

This morning, explore the serene **Arashiyama Bamboo Grove** and walk across the picturesque **Togetsu Bridge**. Next, visit the stunning **Kinkakuji Temple (Golden Pavilion)**. End the day with a **Western Dinner**. (B / L / WD)

Day 8 - Kyoto ~ Nara ~ Kobe

After breakfast, head to Nara to explore **Nara Deer Park** and stroll through the charming **Naramachi area**. Join a fun **sushi-making class** and enjoy your creations for lunch. Afterward, travel to Kobe for a visit to the **Hakutsuru Sake Brewery Museum**, where you'll learn about sake brewing and enjoy a sake tasting. (B / SL)

Day 11 - Osaka / Busan (Korea) (By Air)

Day 12 - Busan

Today, explore **Haedong Yonggungsa Temple** and walk along Busan's famous **Haeundae Beach** and get a ride on **Haeundae Coastal Train**. Take in breathtaking views from the dramatic **Taejongdae Cliff** before concluding the day with a local **Korean Dinner**. (B / L / D)

Day 13 - Busan ~ Gyeongju ~ Ansan

After breakfast, drive to Gyeongju. Today, visit 2 UNESCO Heritage sites – **Seokguram Grotto** and **Bulguksa Temple**, then enjoy a **Buffet Lunch at Ashley Restaurant**. Continue the journey to Ansan. End with a local **Korean Dinner**. (B / SL / D)

Enjoy a **Seafood Steamboat Lunch**, then visit the **War Memorial of Korea** and **N Seoul Tower** (observatory not included). Enjoy **The Painters show** (or Nanta). Dinner on your own. (B / L)

Day 15 - Seoul

This morning, visit **Gyeongbokgung Palace** where you can dress in traditional **Hanbok**. Enjoy a **Ginseng Chicken Soup Lunch**. Then, explore the **National Folk Museum** and **Bukchon Hanok Village**. Enjoy a **Special Farewell Korean BBQ Dinner** and explore **Myeongdong Night Market** before going back to the hotel. (B / L / SD)

Day 16 - Seoul / Hometown

After breakfast, free morning until check out. Then transfer to Incheon International Airport for your Air Canada flight back to Vancouver. (B)
